Principal's Report

Yesterday, Mr O'Leary and I were delighted to accompany our School Captains and Vice-Captains to this year's Young Leaders Conference in Sydney. The five speakers were inspirational in different ways, sharing their views on leadership with six thousand primary students.

The main thoughts that I took from the presenters were:

- "Nothing great, cool or long lasting starts out that way" – Mike Martin, Halogen Foundation
- "You can do it. It is natural to have doubts" – Bob Carr, Former Foreign Minister and NSW Premier
- "What made me different made me strong" – Coen Ashton, 16 year old cystic fibrosis and lung transplant survivor, and advocate for organ donation
- "We only get better at something through practise" - Andy Griffiths, children's author
- "Life is full of detours and opportunities. It is up to me to make the best of what happens" – Ita Buttrose, Journalist and 2013 Australian of the Year.

Each person spoke about how they turned a negative experience into a positive and became leaders in their fields, and how leadership is about influence. Mike Martin also shared that the only difference between the students at the conference and the presenters came down to time and choices they made.

We are all leaders in our own way, whether it is within our families, work or community organisations.

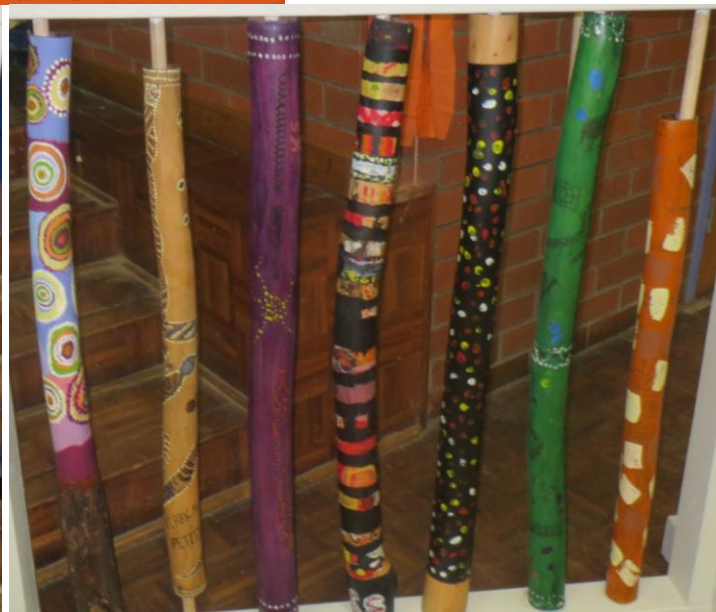
