Principal's Report

Emma Buckland and Walter Smith were the two victors in Stage 2, while Aiden Harland and Ryan Dowling placed in the first two positions in Stage 3.

Pupil Free Day – Show Day

Staff will be involved in a Staff Development Day this Friday, 22 August. The pupil free day has been planned at this time to allow students from Condobolin Public School to attend the show if they wish. Teachers will be involved in developing a deeper understanding of the new Mathematics syllabus which is due to be implemented next year.

Students and Social Media

The rules of social media organizations, Facebook and Snapchat, state that children under the age of 13 years cannot hold an account. In some instances, children under 13 years will be redirected to more appropriate and safer options.

Sites such as Facebook and Snapchat allow for cyber-bullying to occur within the home of the children, often without the carers being aware as social media can be accessed from mobile phones and tablets (iPads) when the children are supposed to be sleeping.

Cyber-bullying includes name-calling and making threats. Are you aware of what your child is writing or photos that they are sharing on social media? Are you setting a good example for the children who are accessing your social media threads?

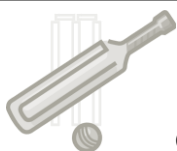

Season: August – December 2014 plus representative competitions until March 2015

When: Tuesday afternoons during terms 3 and 4 – starts August 5th

- Term 3: 4 pm until 5:30 pm – early to catch the light!
- Term 4: 5 pm until 7 pm – late to avoid the heat!

Where: Condobolin High School Oval

Ages: An athlete's age group is determined by their age on September 30, 2014

- Non-competitive: Tiny Tots (will be 3 or 4 on October 1, 2014)
- Competitive: Under 6, U7, U8, U9, U10, U11, U12, U13, U14, U15, U17

Cost: \$70 per athlete for the season (\$60 for 3rd, 4th etc athlete from one family)

- 1 athlete \$70, 2 athletes \$140, 3 athletes \$200, 4 athletes \$260, etc
- Financial assistance may be available from Little Athletics NSW, please enquire at registration

Registration: Register during August in person or online, all athletes must provide proof of age

- **Registration: Saturday August 2nd outside Romo's Café 9 am – 12 pm**
- Online at www.laansw.com.au, 'join up / register', pay online or to the registrar
- Proof of athlete's age must be shown to the registrar (including previous athletes)
- Late registrations accepted 3:30 – 4 pm before Tuesday competitions during August
- All registrations must be finalised by the end of August

Trial period: New athletes can trial Little Athletics for 2 consecutive weeks in August

- After the trial period, registration must be finalised to continue competing

Uniform: Condobolin LA's singlet \$20 to be ordered and paid for in early September

Parents: Little Athletics relies on the assistance of as many parents/carers as possible, however we understand that parents/carers may have other commitments such as work
