Principal's Report

Student half-yearly reports were sent home yesterday. Please contact the school if you did not receive your child's report.

In the last couple of years, there have been some changes in the way in which English and Mathematics are reported.

The expectation across the state for primary students is that there will be an overall English grade and a comment. We understand that this may make it more difficult for parents to identify how well a child is performing in specific areas, such as reading, writing or talking and listening.

Mathematics is now broken into three areas, instead of five as in previous years. Grades are provided for number and algebra, measurement and geometry, and statistics and probability. There is also an overall grade for mathematics.

Parents are reminded that a C grade is one that is at the grade expected level. It means: *The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved an adequate level of competence in the processes and skills.*

When you receive your child's report, please take the time to read the explanation of the grades. The explanations provide a good deal of information around what a student can do.

Molly Stubberfield will be representing Condobolin Public School at the NSW Inter-schools Equestrian Trials at the Sydney International Equestrian Centre, Parramatta, on Wednesday, 17 June to Monday, 22 June. Molly will be competing in the All Primary Division (K - 6) in the events of show jumping, dressage, cross country and hacking. This is a six-day event that attracts over one thousand competitors.

Molly will be attired in white shirt, blue blazer and tweed, jodhpurs, high-top boots and rider's helmet. Her 16-hand horse, *Boganvilla Basil*, will wear a blue saddle cloth, saddle, bridle, boots and plaited tail.

Molly's recent accolade has been to win her age division, 9-13 years, at West Wyalong Stock Horse National for 2015.

Athletics Finals

Our annual athletics carnival will be held on this Friday, 19 June. This is a school day that all students are expected to attend. Children are asked to be at school by 9.00 am to allow rolls to be marked and events to begin on time. Parents and carers are invited to join students to cheer students on. The canteen will be operating, with children encouraged to place orders to ensure that they are able to eat lunch within the 20 minute lunch period. The more helpers that are available in the canteen means that parents will be able to see their children compete in events.

Students will need to have a hat, water bottle, school jumper, and wear sensible sports shoes and either their sports uniform OR their house colours to the athletics carnival. The house colours are:

The discus finals are due to be held tomorrow, however if we cannot hold these due to rain, the finals will be held on Thursday, 18 June. Students aged 8, 9 or 10 years of age competing in the finals will do so in the middle session. Older students are expected to compete in the morning.

As shot put is an event where we would like competitive students to have three throws, finals will be held on the day of the athletics carnival. A second circle will be run for those wishing to have a throw, but who may not be in the finals.

In the event that wet weather causes us to postpone our carnival, normal lessons will be held this Friday and the carnival will be held next Monday, 22 June.

Our school will be able to nominate up to two students for each of the track events and one student for each field event for the Lachlan Zone PSSA Athletics Trials.

Cursive Handwriting

Handwriting can be a difficult skill and requires a healthy amount of practice. Students in 3/4F are mastering penmanship with their good handwriting skills including correct letter formation, pencil grip, paper placement, and body posture. Students are learning about cursive writing – which is simply “joined-up” writing. One of the benefits of cursive writing includes increasing the speed of writing. Children who write quickly generally get more words on the page and produce better quality content. In these samples, children have been learning to join vowels with the letter ‘f’. The more students practice combinations and patterning such as this, the sooner the neuro-motor pathways of the brain and body make them automatically known. ATHLETICS CARNIVAL INFORMATION

2015

Date: Friday 19th June, 2015

Special Note: This year we are running a whole school carnival. Students from K - 6 will be competing in all events on the day. Long Jump and Shot Put have a **competitive** and **non-competitive group**. Students run in their age race (age turning this year). Other activities are Tabloid Sports, Ball Games and Non-competitive High Jump (foam bar).

Track & Field Trials/Finals:

Over the past couple of weeks a significant number of students have participated in trials & finals for Shot Put, Discus, High Jump and 800 metres. Participation points have been collated to House Points.

Starting Time: Events start at 9.20 am. Students are asked to be at school by 9.00 am.

Ribbons: Students receive a 1st, 2nd, 3rd ribbon at the completion of their 70m, 100m & 200m heats, and relays. Ribbons for field event finals, 70m, 100m finals and 200m (timed) finals will be presented at a special athletics assembly, early Term 3. See bulletin for further details.

Track Events: 5 yrs - 7 yrs will run 70m only.
8 yrs - 12/13 yrs will run 100m & 200m.
No finals for 200m. All 200m heats will be timed.

Age Race Finals: All age race finals will be held at around 1.50 pm.
70m - 5 yrs - 7 yrs Finals & 100 m 8 yrs - 12/13 yrs Finals. No 200m finals.

Junior & Senior Relay:

4 x 100m (House Groups)
Relays will begin in the afternoon if time permits. The 4 fastest runners in Junior & Senior age groups will run in the relays. (Names provided by recorder).

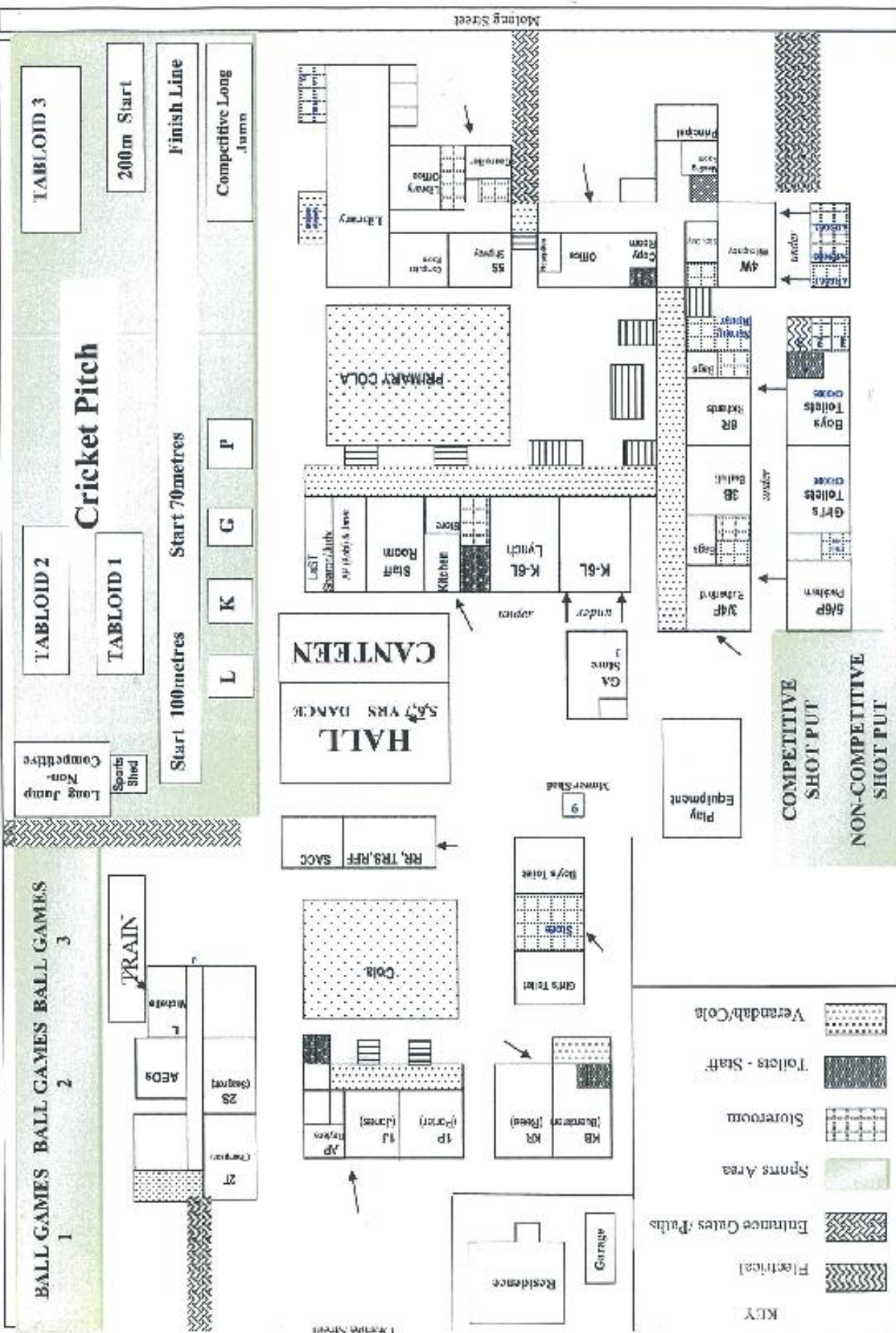
Age Champions: Points will determine the Junior, 11 yrs and Senior over Age Champion. Points will be allocated as follows:
1st = 6 pts
2nd = 4 pts
3rd = 2 pts

Dress: Students may wear house colours or sport uniform.
Please ensure your child has suitable warm clothing and appropriate footwear for competing. Following PSSA regulations, students may run the 100m and 200m events in spikes. Students **MUST** compete in footwear in all events.

Hats: Broad-brimmed hats are required for all K-6 students.

Food: The school canteen will be open as usual. We encourage students to pre-order their lunch. Students may pack their lunch, recess and a healthy snack.

Athletics Assembly: There will be a special athletics assembly early Term 3.
