Principal's Report

Welcome back to a very cool Term 3. It is at this point that we are grateful to have held our athletics carnival in the relative warmth at the end of last term.

We were pleased to see so many students brave the cold weather to attend the first day of school of Term 3 yesterday. Though we advertised extensively that students were to return to school on Monday 13 July, there were still a number of families that were not aware.

Attendance Reports

Each term this year, we will be providing an attendance report for students. The reports being sent home this week relate to the percentage of attendance for students during the ten weeks of Term 2, regardless of whether absences were explained or not.

Sixty-four students had 100% attendance in Term 2. There was also an increase in the number of students attending at least 93%.

Where a student received a red or yellow sticker on the report, and students were not granted extended leave or had medical certificates for illness, a concerted effort needs to be made to improve attendance in the next ten weeks.

Athletics Assembly

A special assembly will be held this Friday, 17 July to make presentations of ribbons, trophies and medallions to a number of students and to the winning house. Parents and carers are invited to attend.

A Snapshot from this week in...

Stage One



Our green thumbed Student Learning Support Officer, Wendy Dargin spends a lot of time gardening with children in Kindergarten, Year One and Year Two. The children were very proud to harvest a crop of eggplants from the vegetable garden last week. Eggplants were not commonly known vegetables across Year 2, so Nell, Abbey and Bonnie researched some information to share with all of Kinder, Year One and Year Two.

Eggplants, also known as aubergines because of their skin colour, are actually fruit. The eggplant is ready to harvest when the skin is shiny. It is not eaten raw and needs to be cooked like a vegetable. Ms Porter took one of the eggplants so she could cook Baba Ghanoush – a traditional Middle Eastern eggplant dish. Mrs Dargin told the students that eggplants need to be picked regularly to encourage more fruit. Let's hope we have plenty more eggplants to harvest.
