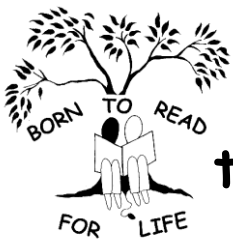

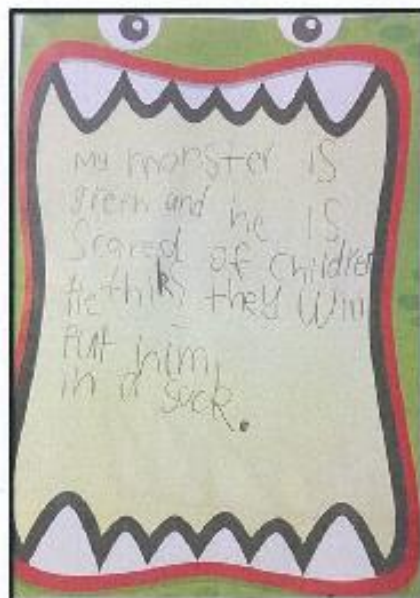
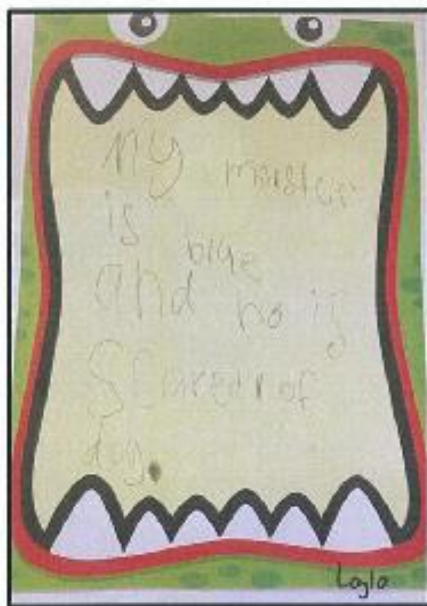
Borrow and swap books from our local library and school library so there are lots of books for your child to choose from.

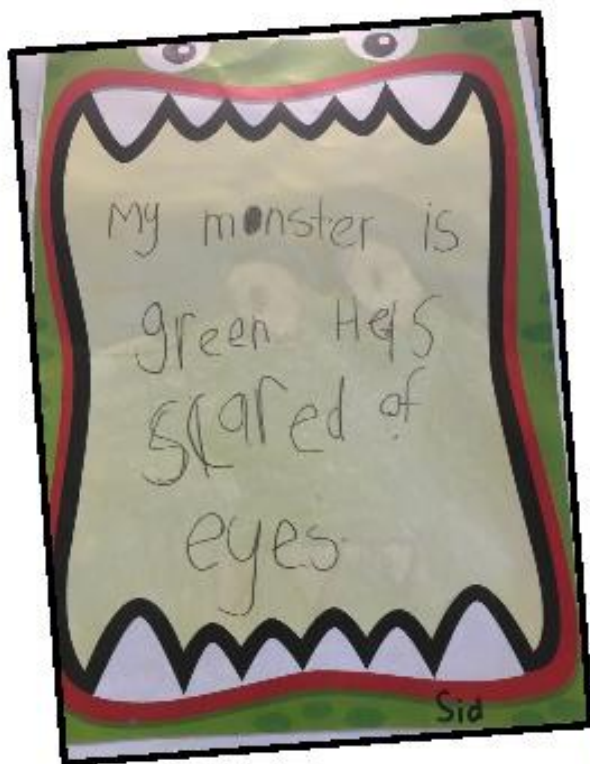

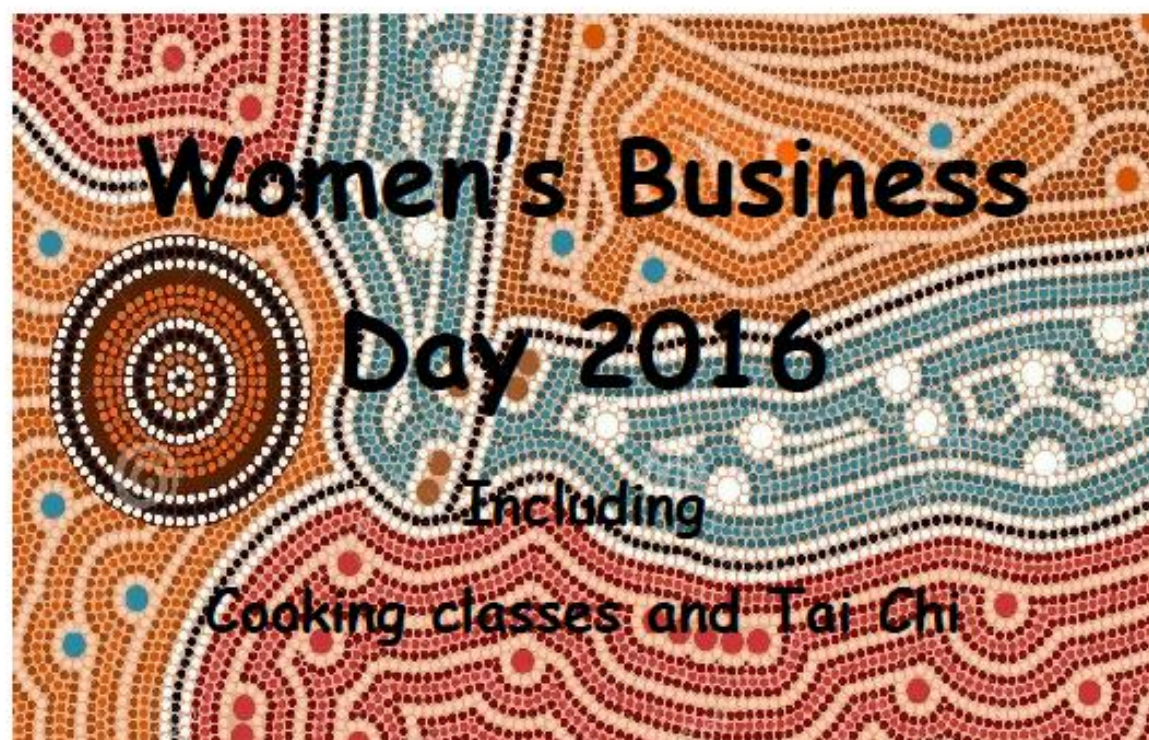
