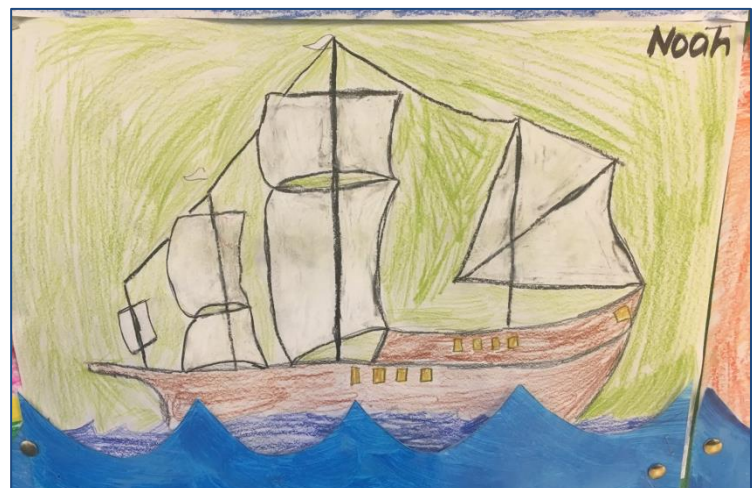
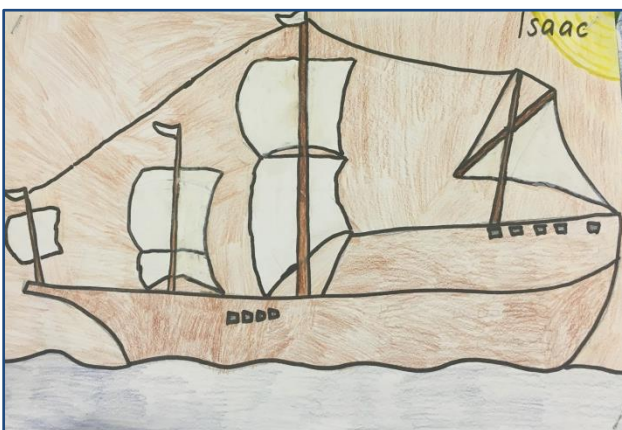
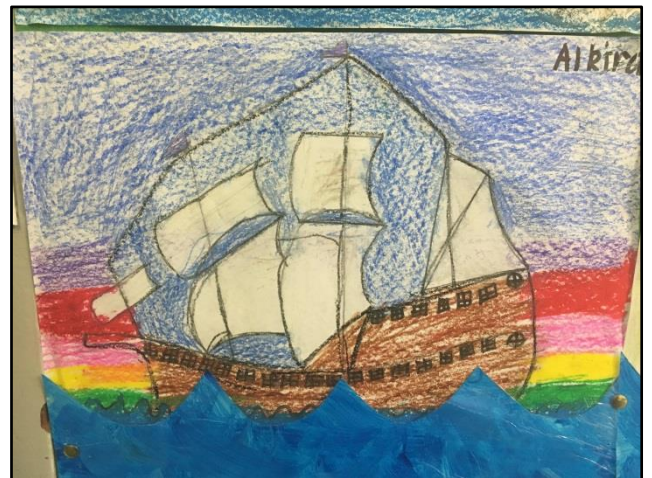
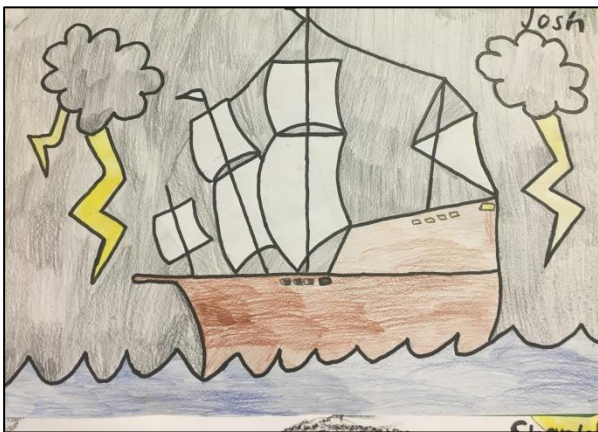
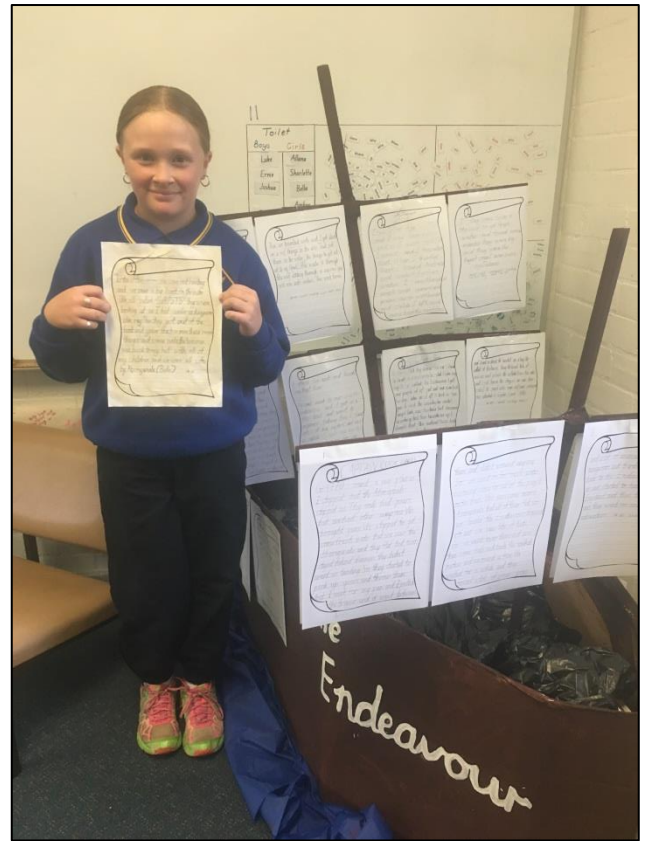


Snapshots from Stage 2 – Class 4B
