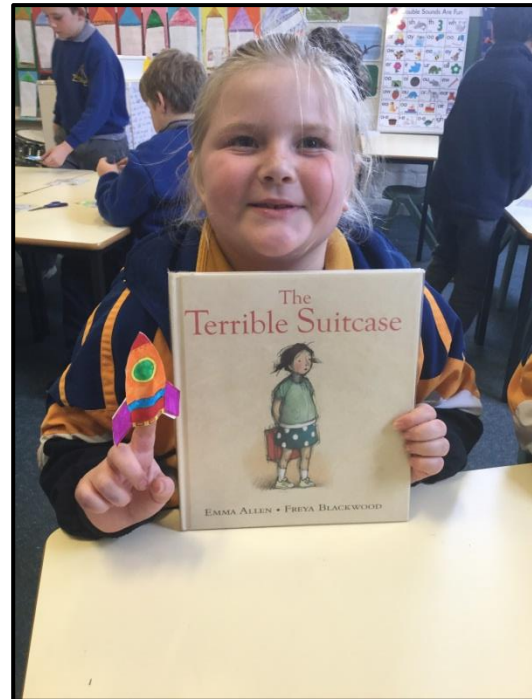
# Snapshots from Year 2 – Buddy Reading

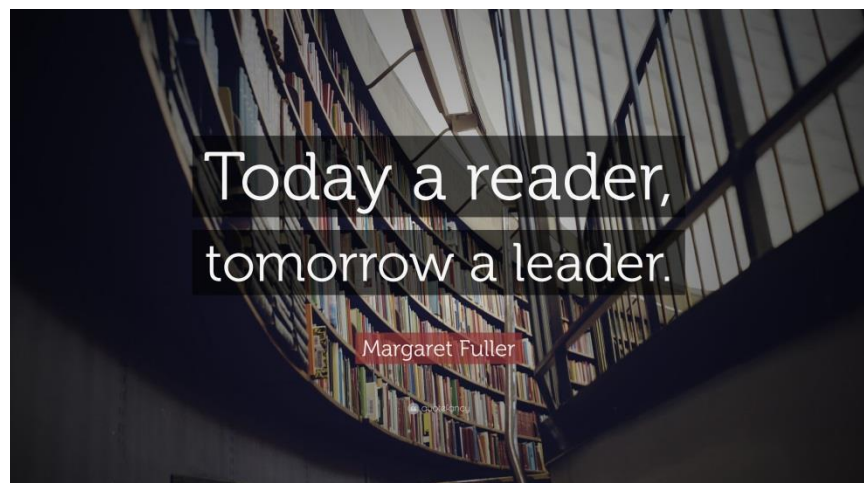

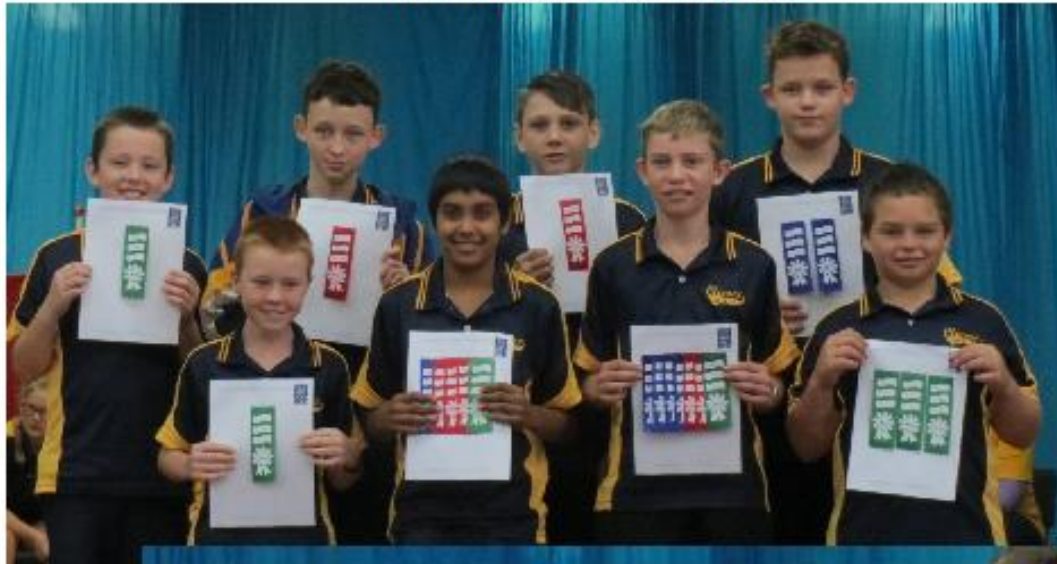

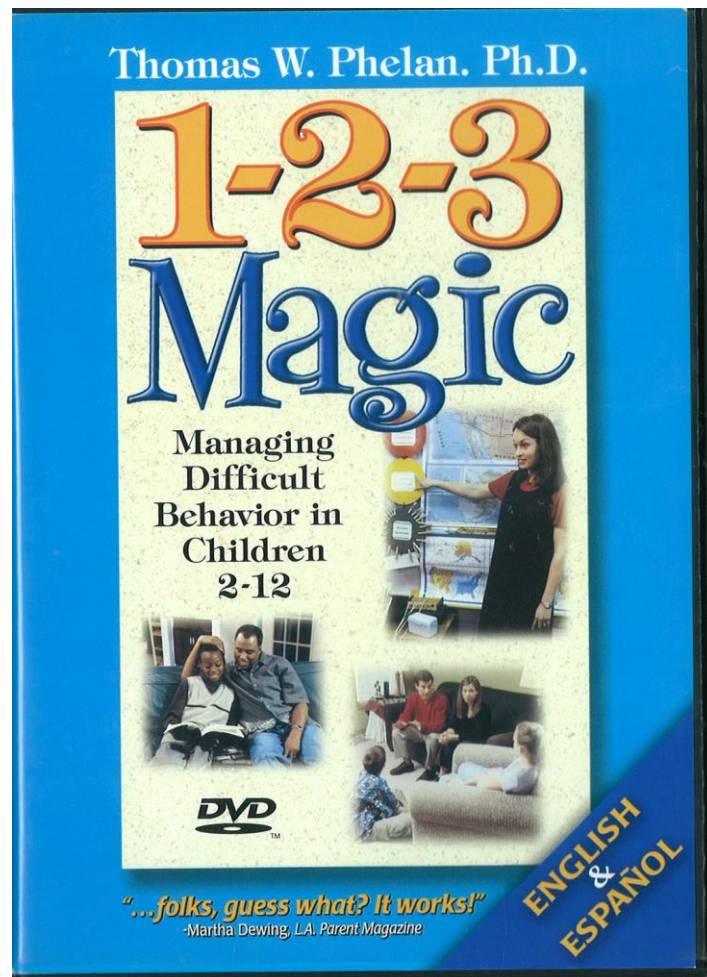
