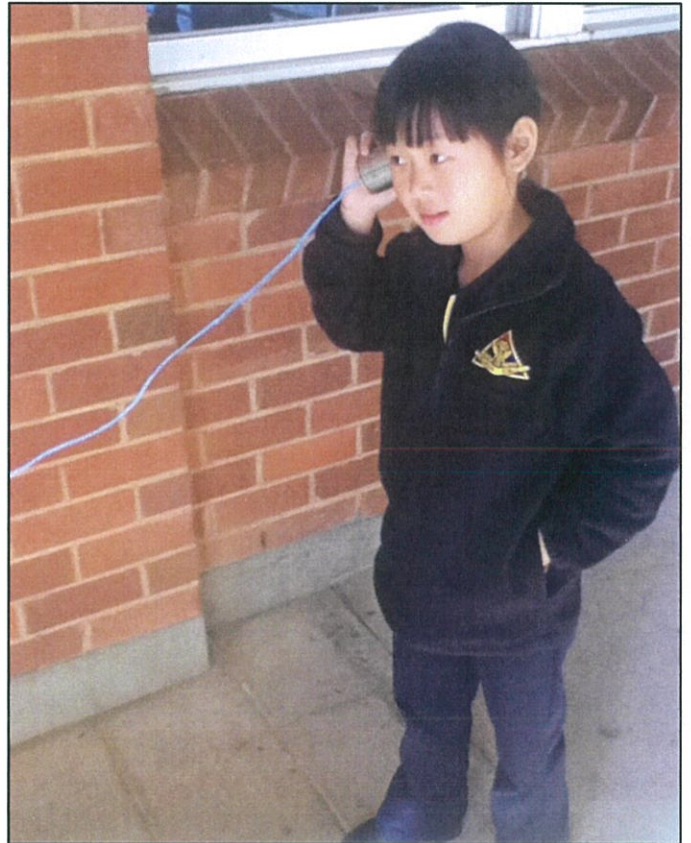

Snapshots from Year 3L

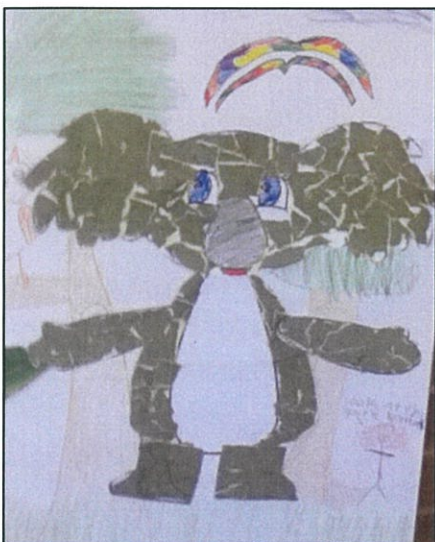
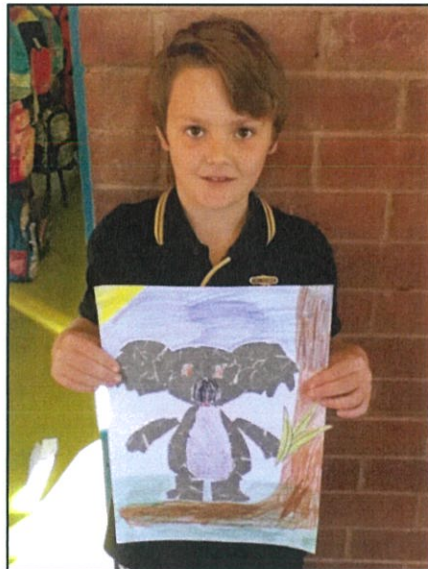
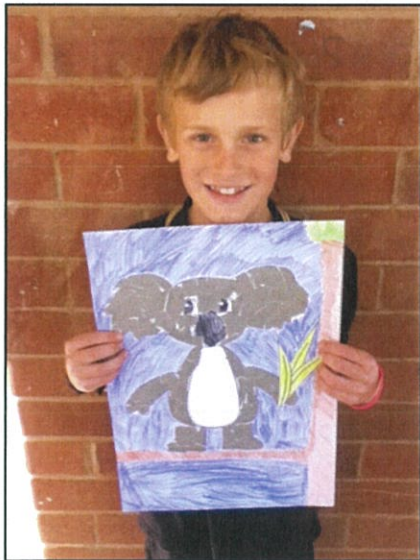
Mrs Leslie is pleased with the enthusiasm of the STRONG, SMART and PROUD students in class 3L. Students have been very interested in learning about communication and how technology has improved communication over time. Students experimented with sending messages using tin can phones. Versions of these phones were used in the 19th Century. They work when sound is converted into vibrations, transferred down a line and converted back into sound. Students learned that the nylon string needed to be pulled very tight before messages could travel from tin to tin. 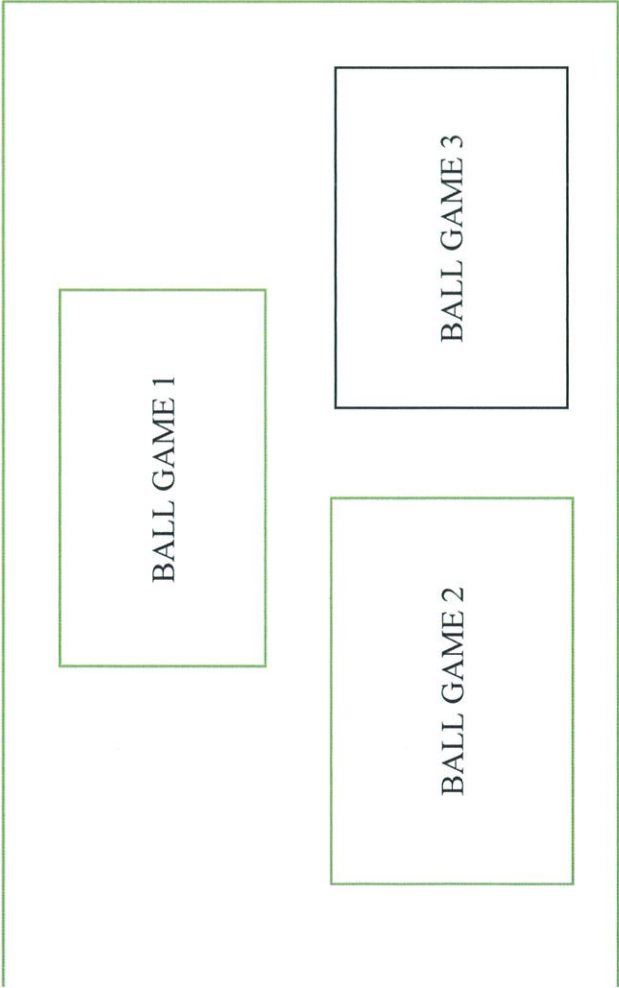

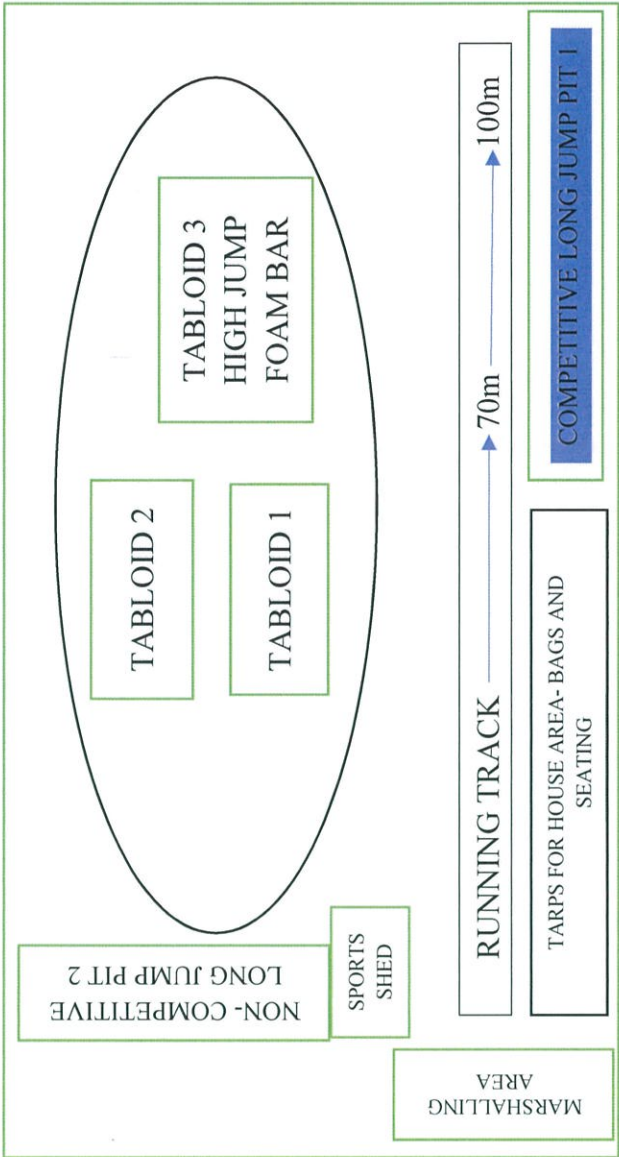

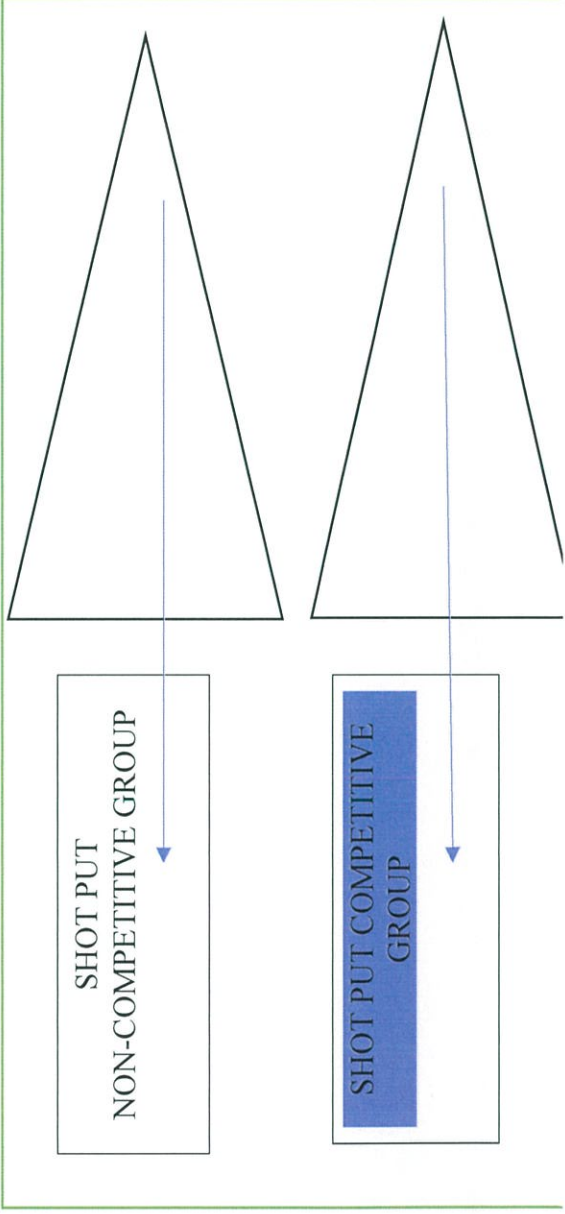
