On Thursday students will have a session with their 2023 class and in the room where their class will be next year. Transitions for Year 2 to the 3-6 playground have been in place and the kindergarten interviews have been conducted with great anticipation for the first day next year.

Additional sheltered seating will be added to the outside of the primary oval and K-2 oval through the holidays. This will allow for students to sit in shaded spaces when not playing directly in oval games. During Term 1, designs and images are to be painted on to the cemented areas of the K-2 playground including snakes and ladders, road map for toy car play, sensory path and more.

### Additional Staff Development Day 19th December 2022

As we near the end of the year, I want to thank you for your ongoing support and to remind you of a date change for the last day of Term 4 classes.

**Students will now finish school on Friday 16 December 2022.** This is due to an additional School Development Day announced for staff across NSW Public Schools.

School Development days allow our staff to participate in professional learning that was put on hold due to COVID-19 staffing pressures and plan for 2023 to ensure we meet the needs of our students. While there will be no classes on Monday 19 December if you cannot arrange alternative care for your child we will; provide minimal supervision at school.



Stage One students explored how eating healthy foods can benefit their health. Students had fun making their own fruit kebab.





















Students in Stage One have been learning how to play 'matball' during sport. Students love completing movement breaks outside!

Friday: Year 6 lunch at Cafe Romo


